

Courteous visit to Deputy Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, India



UK University Fees set to be without limits

Universities in England should be able to charge unlimited fees, a major review of university funding has recommended.

Lord Browne's review calls for the £3,290 cap on fees, which students borrow in loans, to be scrapped. Instead it proposes a free market in fees - setting out models of charges up to £12,000 a year for a degree course. The UCU lecturers' union said the plan was "the final nail in the coffin for affordable higher education".

However, Lord Browne's review makes clear that universities that charge more than £6,000 a year would lose a proportion of the fee to help cover the cost of student borrowing. He said all universities were different and needed different amounts of money to retain their world class status, but he predicted that few would put fees very high. He acknowledged graduates would be paying significantly more back in their tuition fee and maintenance loans but insisted they were not being left with "mortgage-style debts".

UK cash for education in developing countries targets conflict zones

Half of Britain's budget for education in the developing world is now to be spent on schooling in war-torn countries, the Department for International Development (Dfid) announced today.

As part the international drive to secure education for the 72 million potential students who are out of school, some £300m will be targeted at fragile and conflict-affected countries, including Somalia and the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

The UK will devote a total of £600m for bilateral spending on education, while another £400m will go through organisations such as the World Bank and the European commission.

Dfid's new strategy outlines proposals to support 5.5 million students to go to study every year, build 15,000 new classrooms in a year and train 130,000 teachers annually.


